## MINUTES:

\* Hardwick read the minutes of the February 14<sup>th</sup> meeting. Patterson moved, Green seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

## ZONING:

\* Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, Tom Rensch as chairman and Gene Ebert as vice chairman for the zoning board of commission and Dan Wood as chairman and Tom Blankenship as vice chairman for the zoning appeals board. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

## FINANCIAL:

\* The following bills were presented to the board for examination (listed at end of minutes): 16471-16487. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to approve said bills. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* Hardwick presented the Township's Cash Summary by Fund report and Fund Status report. The February bank reconciliation was distributed for signing by the board. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to accept them as submitted. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

## ZONING:

\* #474 Jeremy Conant, 2995 TR 124 pole barn extension – cost of construction \$25,000 - fee \$25.

## ROADS:

\* Some pot holes are showing up in township roads. Crawford Construction has replaced culverts on TR 152 and TR 144. They have billed for 80% of their respective contracts. Paving and finish work still needs to be completed. Trustees discussed whether guardrails are to be installed. The county engineer had included guardrails for TR 152 in his initial estimate. However, he removed guardrails in the design plans that went to bid. TR 144 culvert work does include guardrails. Wilhelm has ordered high water signs. He will also order the orange and black barber pole signs for the culvert on TR 152. Wilhelm has left two messages for Iberia Earthworm to get a quote for paving of TR 124. Hardwick received an email from ODOT that the Township did not receive their grant to replace the culvert at TR 144 and CR 125. Trustees discussed whether this culvert is the Township's or County's responsibility. Heacock will contact the county engineer. Always Chipper has started trimming trees again. Trustees would like to open bids for summer road work at the April meeting. Hardwick will place an ad in the Morrow County Sentinel.

## EQUIPMENT:

\* The Ford truck was serviced at Mathews for the recall and is ready to be picked up. Wilhelm needs to order a plate for the mower.


## DISCUSSION:


\* Davies spoke as the incumbent for Morrow County Auditor. Real estate sales are very high in the county, property tax values will go up in next year's reappraisals.

\* Siegfried, Morrow County Commissioner, confirmed that the County will be opening bids for summer paving soon.


