Cardington Township held their regular meeting on May 9, 2022 at 7:00 PM in the township garage. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

Trustees: Heacock and Patterson. (Green called with car trouble.)

Fiscal Officer: Hardwick.

Zoning Inspector: Robinson.

Employees: Bouillon, Moss, Wilhelm.

Others: Susan Garverick, Stephanie McDonough, and Kenny Underwood; Steven Hummell Jr. and Cinnamon Potter; David Smith; and Tory Miller-Morrow County Health Department.

MINUTES:

* Hardwick read the minutes of the April 11th meeting. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to approve the minutes as read and corrected. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes.

FINANCIAL:

* The following bills were presented to the board for examination (listed at end of minutes): 16515-16528. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to approve said bills. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes.

* Hardwick presented the Township's Cash Summary by Fund report and Fund Status report. The April bank reconciliation was distributed for signing by the board. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to accept them as submitted. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes.

* Heacock moved, Patterson seconded to increase the road levy fund (2141) appropriation by \$14,390 for TR 124 paving. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes.

* Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to adopt a resolution to apply solely to procurement using federal funds. (Resolution attached) Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes.

ZONING:

* #476 James Everman, 4534 CR 9 new house – cost of construction \$150,000 - fee \$82.50.

* Robinson shared that he has posted the 2022 minutes to the township website. He will continue to do so monthly and leave up for approximately one year.

* Garverick (owner of storage facility on CR 9) stated that she bought the DeForest property on US Rt 42 at auction. She plans to renovate the house and rent it, tear down the old barns (possibly burn), and construct more rental storage units along the back of the property (off CR 143). She had zoning questions. Robinson & trustees informed her that 1,000 feet along Rt 42 is already zoned commercial. She was advised to come up with drawings and a plan to determine if a zoning variance would be required or not.

* Potter and Hummell shared their continued problems with the people living in the Maniaci property on CR 149. Heacock shared that he contacted the county prosecutor; this property has not been filed in probate court and that Green contacted the health department. The trustees and Robinson visited the property on Wednesday, May 4. They spoke to the person living there and told him about the complaints they have received. They gave him 30 days. Miller from the health department shared that she had visited the property last fall or winter and spoke to him. She has seen some improvement since then. Trustees stated that the authority to foreclose on the property for the unpaid taxes is with the County.

ROADS:

* Wilhelm reported that they started cold patching holes last month and hot mix will be available this week. TR 136 had some damage; they need to do some work to this before Iberia can repave it. Mowing will start soon. There is a plugged culvert on CR 138 before CR 11; Wilhelm would like to have Steve Gordon jet it out and possibly put a grate over it. Crawford Construction plans to complete paving for TR 152 and 144 culverts and guardrails on TR 144 this week – weather pending. Newman has not sent the new road signs yet.

EQUIPMENT:

* The equipment is in good shape. Heacock priced a torch from two companies. One was about \$1,500. OE Meyer offered it for about \$1,200. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to purchase

the torch from Meyer. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes. Hardwick will complete the credit application from OE Meyer.

MISC:

* Miller shared that DKMM is offering a grant to help cover a portion of the cost for residential tire removal. The Village of Cardington is participating in this. Heacock told her he received a phone call from a resident inquiring about burial on their property; Miller said to call Lynn at the health department for that information.

* Hardwick reported that the Township is to have a BWC audit on June 7 at her house. She also shared that she completed the required ARPA reporting that was due April 30; she had to choose an option for use of funds and used revenue loss. All money that will be spent from this grant has to be reported by project.

* Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to move the Township's June meeting from June 13 to June 20 due to a schedule conflict. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes.

* Patterson shared that the State is proposing eliminating the local district health advisory council and giving that authority to the county commissioners. He is drafting a letter on behalf of the Morrow County Township Association in opposition to this proposal. He has also heard that ODOT has stopped the pursuit of the US 23 corridor project.

* There will be a Morrow County Township Association meeting on June 16. There was discussion about the solar farm project in Washington Township, concern about reclamation of the land after the project, and possible interest of a solar farm in Cardington Township.

Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to adjourn. Time 8:20 PM.
