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- * Green presented Bart Wilhelm with a signed proclamation from the Township thanking Wilhelm for his 14 years of service to Cardington Township.
- * Moss reported that the road crew has been trimming and spraying, mowed a third time, crack patching, and filling potholes. JR Levering has jetted three culverts. Iberia Earthworm completed summer paving project; there is a berming issue on TR 136, and Iberia will come back to re-roll. The berm needs to be built up on this road and possibly some ditch work.

EQUIPMENT:

- * Heacock shared that he picked up a chainsaw from Miller Equipment. He also had quotes for a variety of used backhoes from Southeastern Equipment. In order to comply with the federal procurement policy, he is going to obtain more quotes. Scott Beveridge offered to inquire if Kokosing Construction might have any used backhoes they are disposing of. Heacock also tried to get a quote from Young's for a generator and installation. Young's said they are too busy. Heacock will contact another vendor for a quote.
- * Moss said all the equipment has been cleaned and running well other than the dump truck. It is still at Aber's Truck for repair. There was a fuel issue, sensor, wiring harness, brake sensor. These repairs so far are priced at \$2,000. It just started leaking coolant a new radiator will be \$1,600. Trustees said to get it repaired and in use.
- * Wilhelm said that the dump truck at Anchor Preservations was for landscaping and not what the township needs.

MISC:

- * The Township has not received specs from the County Engineer for the TR 129 culvert replacement. Once received, Hardwick will advertise for bids at September meeting. Hardwick reported that Township received the second round of American Rescue Plan funding; it included an additional \$227.90. The indigent burial reimbursement was submitted to the State; an email was received that the reimbursement was approved but the Township has not yet received the money. Ohio Edison left communication to report power outages and keep transmission lines clear.
- * Trustees discussed that the Village had a truck stolen from their garage and should the Township look into a security system and would that require telephone or internet service. Heacock will obtain some prices. Beveridge recommended Ring Cameras.
- * Heacock moved, Green seconded, to provide an option to employees (not elected officials) to be paid bimonthly instead of monthly. The pay period would be the 1st-15th and the 16th-31st. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes. Bouillon and Moss would like to be paid bimonthly, and Robinson monthly. Hardwick will need to contact OPERS and UAN to help set this up.
- * Patterson obtained an application from the Village of Crestline for indigent burial. Green moved, Heacock seconded, to have an application for indigent burials and that the Trustees approve/disapprove said applications. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes. Hardwick will use the Crestline application as a template to create an application for the Township.
- * Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to adjourn into executive session in accordance with O.R.C. 121.22 (G)(2) to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of a public employee or official.
