Held October 10, 2022

Cardington Township held their regular meeting on October 10, 2022 at 7:00 PM in the township garage. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

Trustees: Heacock, Patterson and Green.

Fiscal Officer: Hardwick.

Employees: Bouillon and Moss.

Others: Levi Facemyer and David Smith.

MINUTES:

\* Hardwick read the minutes of the September 12th meeting. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

FINANCIAL:

\* The following bills were presented to the board for examination (listed at end of minutes): 16627-16656 and electronic payments 16 & 17. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to approve said bills. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* Hardwick presented the Township's Cash Summary by Fund report and Fund Status report. The September bank reconciliation was distributed for signing by the board. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to accept them as submitted. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* Green moved, Patterson seconded, to increase appropriations for OPWC TR129-state share (fund 4403) by \$5,000 to a total of \$68,569. This is to correct Hardwick's typo on the July agenda. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* Hardwick shared that the \$15,000 appropriation increase to the road levy fund last month was used for the extra cost of the OPWC project, toward the cost of the tractor repair, and other supplies such as road signs. The Township is responsible for 100% of the cost over the engineer's estimate for the OPWC culvert replacement project. Trustees discussed current fund balances. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to increase appropriations in the road levy fund (fund 2141) by an additional \$15,000 to a total of \$125,277.00. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

DISCUSSION:

\* Levi Facemyer, sales representative with Southeastern Equipment, spoke with Trustees. The backhoe approved for purchase at the September meeting was not suitable after in-person inspection/driving. Facemyer provided a different option that better suited the Township's needs.

\* Heacock moved, Green seconded, to rescind the motion from the September meeting to purchase a 2012 Case backhoe from Southeastern Equipment in the amount of \$48,000. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* Heacock moved, Green seconded, to accept the bid from Southeastern Equipment Company for the 2008 Case backhoe in the amount of \$36,000. The Township elects to use the standard allowance and its presumption of revenue loss due to the public health emergency, pay with ARPA funds, project namely provides road repair, maintenance and other transportation and safety services. (Resolution attached) Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ZONING:

\* Robinson was not able to attend due to surgery. No permits were issued.

ROADS:

\* Moss reported that road salt has been ordered from Mitchell Trucking. Water is going over the road during heavy rains on TR124 east of the bridge. Moss thinks this needs ditch work; he will ask Steve Gordon for his opinion. He received the new road signs that he ordered.

EQUIPMENT:

\* The tractor went to AgPro to repair a fuel leak. The tractor came back and is still leaking. Township will not mail the check for the repair until the problem is resolved. The grader needs repaired.





- \* To improve the security of the Township building, trustees discussed starting with installing new man doors. They will obtain quotes and use ARPA funding. They also discussed that the Township will need a new dump truck.
  - \* The indigent burial application was emailed to Smith, County Prosecutor. He replied that the application is fine, but Township would still have to pay for indigent burial if applicant refused to complete application. Green will share application with Gompf Funeral Home for their opinion.
  - \* The Township's current electric aggregation with Dynegy-Aspen Energy expires August 1, 2023. Aspen Energy may attend the November meeting. Hardwick will try to contact Trebel Energy and First Energy to see if they want to provide a proposal.
  - \* Bart Wilhelm has stopped mowing the yard at the Township building. Heacock moved, Green seconded, to pay Keegan Moss to mow the yard at the Township building at \$50/mow starting the first week of October. Moss will provide the equipment and do it on his own time. The Township does not own a mower and deems it more cost effective to hire this service out. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.
  - \* Patterson shared that the Township's bicentennial will be in 2023. He provided logo options and discussed newsletter ideas. The OTA annual conference fee is increasing to \$125.
