Cardington Township held their regular meeting on December 12, 2022 at 7:00 PM in the township garage. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock. Trustees: Heacock, Patterson and Green. Fiscal Officer: Hardwick. Zoning Inspector: Robinson. Employees: Bouillon and Moss. Other: David Smith, Jay Sell and Ray - Aspen Energy

MINUTES:

\* Hardwick read the minutes of the November 14th meeting. Patterson moved, Green seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

DISCUSSION:

\* Jay Sell thanked the Township for the current relationship with Aspen Energy/Dynegy for electric aggregation. The current agreement with him expires August 2023, and the current rate is five cents per kilowatt hour. He advised that right now is not the right time to lock in an electric rate; wait and see where rates are in March. He speculated eight cents then, possibly twelve cents later on.

FINANCIAL:

\* The following bills were presented to the board for examination (listed at end of minutes): 16674-16692 and electronic payment 22. Heacock moved, Green seconded, to approve said bills. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* Hardwick presented the Township's Cash Summary by Fund report and Fund Status report. The November bank reconciliation was distributed for signing by the board. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to accept them as submitted. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* Heacock moved, Green seconded, to increase gas tax fund appropriations by \$2,500. This is for additional expenses through the end of the year including December payroll. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ZONING:

\* Robinson shared that he posted the minutes to the Township's website, and he submitted a receipt to be reimbursed for Word Press for website.

\* Lot split Todd Etgen, CR136 near TR134 & TR66 fee \$100.

ROADS:

\* Moss reported some stop signs were shot up; he reported it to the State Highway Patrol. He will need to order additional signs. They will work on trees and ditches in the new year. Rod Clinger will take down the dead trees. Moss told CenturyLink about the hole at TR128 & TR129.

EQUIPMENT:

\* Moss will service the tractor in the new year.

MISC:

\* Hardwick informed trustees that the road levy will need to be placed on the ballot next fall as renewal or replacement, and the cemetery levy is up the following fall.

\* The year-end meeting will be December 29th at 7:00 PM, and the organizational meeting will be after the joint meeting with the Village on January 3rd at 6:30 PM.

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\* Patterson attended the School Board meeting prior to Township meeting to learn about the Safe Route 2 Schools plan. This is the planning phase, then there will be a time for public comment, then to ODOT. The plan includes sidewalks, bike path, signage, and lighting.

Patterson moved, Green seconded, to adjourn. Time 7:50 PM.
