Held February 21, 2023

Cardington Township held a special meeting on February 21, 2023 at 7:00 PM in the township office. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.  
Trustees: Heacock, Patterson, Green.  
Fiscal Officer: Hardwick.

MINUTES:

\* Hardwick read the minutes of the February 13<sup>th</sup> meeting. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

FINANCIAL:

\* The following bills were presented to the board for examination (listed at end of minutes): 16744-16747 and electronic payment 5. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to approve said bills. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

EQUIPMENT:

\* Heacock reported that Moss and him inspected a Freightliner truck at Concord Township, and asked them numerous questions about their experience. One item that Concord Township recommended was rear differential lock for the truck. Heacock will inquire about that change with Fyda Freightliner.

As noted in the February 13 meeting, the Township obtained three quotes for trucks from three vendors. These vendors provided State of Ohio pricing through ODOT.

Heacock moved, Green seconded, to accept the bid from Fyda Freightliner for the 2023 dump truck in the amount of \$94,842. The Township elects to use the standard allowance and its presumption of revenue loss due to the public health emergency, pay with ARPA funds, project namely provides road repair, maintenance and other transportation and safety services. The total amount of ARPA funds remaining are \$78,445.37. The remaining \$16,396.63 will be paid from Road Fund (fund 2031). (Resolution attached) Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to approve the modified bid from The Dexter Co. to outfit the new dump truck in the amount of \$83,400. This will be paid from the Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund (2011) and the Road Fund (2031). The original bid was modified to exclude the purchase of a new salt box and to include an extra light, tarp, and lube system. (The salt box was already purchased by the Township at the last meeting, because the current salt box was damaged. The insurance company was contacted – a claim may be filed. The insurance company requested a quote for the repair of the damaged salt box.)

\* Trustees plan to sell old truck and equipment once new truck is received and verified to be in working order.

MISC:

\* Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to increase appropriations as follows:

Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green, yes.

\* Green shared that he talked to the County Prosecutor on February 14, the day after the regular meeting, about the Maniaci property. He feels that the best step for this property would be for the County Treasurer to foreclose the property due to unpaid taxes. There is

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currently a transition in County Treasurer; Green will go see him after he settles into office. Trustees have driven by the property. It looks unkept with lots of stuff outside, but trash is not visible. If there is trash piling up, it would be a Health Department issue.

\* Trustees discussed that Leonard Robinson's term serving Regional Planning Commission will be up in March. Trustees will ask Robinson if he will continue to represent the Township.

Green moved, Heacock seconded, to adjourn. Time 7:35 PM.
