Cardington Township held their regular meeting on April 10, 2023 at 7:00 PM in the township garage. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

Trustees: Heacock, Patterson, Green.

Fiscal Officer: Hardwick.

Employee: Moss.

Others: Tim Abraham and David Smith.

MINUTES:

* Hardwick read the minutes of the March 13th meeting. Patterson moved, Green seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

FINANCIAL:

* The following bills were presented to the board for examination (listed at end of minutes): 16765-16785 and electronic payments 8, 10, 11. Heacock moved, Green seconded, to approve said bills. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

* Hardwick presented the Township's Cash Summary by Fund report and Fund Status report. The March bank reconciliation was distributed for signing by the board. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to accept them as submitted. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

DISCUSSION:

* Trustees discussed the draft audit report and signed the representation letter.

* Tim Abraham, County Commissioner, provided an update of County activities. He was asked about the barricades at the old intersection of CR 11 and US 42. He replied that Bonecutter owns it.

ZONING:

* Hardwick reported that the lot split for Morrow County Parks has been paid.

* Heacock asked David Smith if he would like to fill Gene Ebert's vacated position on the zoning commission board starting 2024.

* Trustees discussed that the Morrow County land bank had a meeting and the Maniaci property was discussed. They have another meeting on April 19.

ROADS:

* Moss provided a report of road work: fixing/straightening signs, cleaning up tree limbs, filling potholes. He plans to order gravel for berming on TR 144. JR Levering jetted the culvert on TR 138 - nothing was plugging it.

* Heacock reported that the County Engineer provided Crawford Construction with specs for the culvert excavation work on TR 144 & CR 125. Crawford still has not provided an estimate for this work.

* Trustees discussed that the landowner at the curve of TR 138 has placed concrete blocks in the road right-of-way. Trustees will go talk to him.

EQUIPMENT:

* Moss expressed concern about the floor in the salt shed: it either needs fill put under it or concrete. Township will get a quote for concrete.

* Boe Christian quoted \$4,200 for two doors and \$3,400 to hang them at the Township building.

* Freightliner communicated that the new truck will be built in June or July. Trustees discussed the grader; it is deteriorating, taking up a lot of space, requires many repairs to keep running.

MISC:

* Hardwick completed public records training for elected officials. Hardwick and Patterson watched the videos for the ODOT safety sign grant. There will be a joint meeting with the village

on May 1 at 6:30 to discuss cemetery business. Hardwick reported that an annual report for ARPA funds is due April 30.

* The fire department requested use of Township's road closed signs in emergency situations. Trustees agreed to give them a key to the building and use of signs.

* Due to crashes on US 42 in the Township, Chief Gary Goodman requested Township to purchase two "emergency ahead" signs for the fire department. Approximate cost is \$533 plus shipping. Green moved, Patterson seconded, to approve this purchase for the fire department with the excess tornado insurance proceeds in the fire fund. This motion also includes increasing appropriations in the fire fund by this amount. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

* Patterson shared that no groups have signed up for trash bash in Cardington Township yet. He thinks the latest electric auction had rates of 10.11 cents per kilowatt hour – trustees are pleased that they locked in at 7.05 cents. Patterson has communicated with the Morrow County Genealogical Society for the history of Cardington Township. Morven Township was established in 1823 and renamed Cardington Township in 1850; 2023 is the bicentennial of Cardington Township. Trustees discussed newsletter ideas.

* Green moved, Patterson seconded to approve OTA membership for Robinson and Moss at \$25 each. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

Green moved, Patterson seconded, to adjourn. Time 8:30 PM.
