Cardington Township held their regular meeting on December 11, 2023 at 7:00 PM in the township office. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

TRUCK BIDS:

Heacock opened sealed bids for the 2008 GMC dump truck including plow and damaged salt box.

Bucher Excavating - \$10,001

Matt Crum - \$10,000

John Carpenter - \$12,000

Brock Goodman - \$10,000

Crum verbally increased his bid to \$12,500. Carpenter and Crum continued to raise the bid by \$500 increments. Bidding stopped with Matt Crum at \$14,500. Heacock moved, Green seconded, to approve Matt Crum's bid for the 2008 GMC dump truck for \$14,500 and authorize Heacock to sign the title over to Crum after his payment to the Township has cleared the bank. Heacock instructed Crum to get a check to Hardwick. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

MINUTES

* Hardwick read the minutes of the November 13th meeting. Patterson moved, Green seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ZONING

- * Toombs was out of town for work and not able to attend to the meeting. He emailed his zoning report to Hardwick who read it. Toombs issued a zoning certificate for an accessory building on CR137, the Health Dept visited the Mollett property on US42, still working on junk vehicles on TR141, and looking into a complaint on CR66.
- * Patterson reported that he spoke to Makenzie Coulter who was interested in serving on the zoning board of commission. Heacock moved, Green seconded, to ask Makenzie Coulter to serve on the zoning board of commission. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.
- * Patterson has not received a proposal from Plan 4 Land.

ROADS:

- * Moss reported that he has one day of mowing left, and he has also been berming. He has disposed of tires that road crew have picked up as litter. Road crew plans to fill potholes this week. Moss spoke to Joe Jakubik, Ohio Edison, about moving the electric pole on TR144; Jakubik will inform their Marion office. The bridge on CR28 has been replaced and the road is reopened. Crawford Construction replaced the culvert on TR144 and CR125. Crawford will lay asphalt and install guardrails in the spring; Crawford also returned the concrete blocks at this intersection to the township hall.
- * Moss obtained an estimate from Always Chipper to trim and remove dead trees up from roadway 30 feet on TR129 and TR132. Their price is \$175/hour, and they estimated a total of 25 hours. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to approve Always Chipper as estimated. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.
- * Heacock spoke to Reeder on TR139. Reeder is fine with Township taking down the dead tree. Heacock has asked Rod Clinger to drop the tree.

EOUIPMENT:

- * Moss reported that all equipment is running, other than the battery in the backhoe is dead. Moss will service the Ford truck. Hartman Printing will put lettering on the new dump truck on Friday. Moss would like three new first aid boxes for trucks and shop. Heacock will look for them at Harbor Freight. Moss donated shelves and work bench for the shop.
