Cardington Township held their regular meeting on February 12, 2024 at 7:00 PM in the township office. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

DISCUSSION:

* Wick spoke as candidate for Morrow County Prosecutor. Goodman, Village fire chief, reviewed 2023 fire department runs and grants that were received. Siegfried spoke as candidate for Morrow County Commissioner and provided an update of county activities.

MINUTES:

* Hardwick read the minutes of the January 8th meeting. Green moved, Patterson seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ZONING:

* Permit #020824CT Garrett Casto, 2940 TR 129, new house, fee \$393.

* Toombs reported that he will continue to follow up with Mollett (US Rt 42) about status of survey for lot split and complaint of junk vehicles. He had contact with Flores (TR139); they have a contract with a builder and will need to obtain a temporary housing permit. He spoke with McGee (Davis property on TR141) about junk vehicles; her significant other had surgery, and they will work on the situation - Toombs will follow up. Toombs stopped twice at the new build on TR 66, no one there, he will send a letter. Toombs is waiting to hear back from Dan at the Health Department about the camper on the Maniaci (TR 149) property. R Touch Properties (TR 143 and US Rt 42) wants to sell their property but inquired if it is zoned as commercial; it is the trustees understanding that property along US Rt 42 - up to 1000 feet - is zoned commercial.

* Trustees discussed the Plan4Land proposal. Patterson shared that he attended the update on zoning code at the OTA conference. OTA recommends that townships update their zoning codes. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to accept Plan4Land basic service project proposal at a cost of \$3,000 in order to update the Township's zoning regulations. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ROADS:

* Moss reported the road crew cleaned up after a high wind storm, cleared roads from snow, and did some cold patching of potholes.

* Moss would like to open bids for summer road work at the March meeting. Trustees asked him to put together bid specifications, and Hardwick will put an advertisement in the Sentinel.

EQUIPMENT:

* The trucks are clean, backhoe serviced, and tractor will be serviced. Moss received an offer from Seal Master that if you buy two skid loads of their crack patch, they will let you use their machine for a week.

MISC:

* Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to request certification by the county auditor for the renewal of the cemetery levy for the purpose of maintaining and operating cemeteries in Cardington Township, pursuant to Section 5705.19(T) of the Ohio Revised Code, at a rate not exceeding 2.6 mills for each one dollar of valuation for three years commencing 2025, first due in calendar year 2026. This will be for the general election on November 5, 2024. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

FINANCIAL:

* Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to inspect and sign checks 16971-16992 and electronic payment 2. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

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

MISC:


