MINUTES:

* Hardwick read the minutes of the August 5th meeting. Heacock moved, Green seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ZONING:

- * In regards to the Maniaci property Toombs, Heacock, and Green met with the brother who is residing at the residence. He is working on cleaning up, and he has mowed. They gave him guidance that he still needs to trim the weeds, dispose of fridge and cans. They were pleased that he was working on clean up. They will drive by in one month and continue to monitor. It was noted that one vehicle on the property needs to be probated.
- * Toombs reported that he has played phone tag with Mollett (US Rt 42) about the status of their lot split and that the cell tower on TR 128 is going to come down.
- * Makenzie Coulter, zoning board of commission member, has moved out of the township. Trustees will need to find a resident to replace her on the board.

- * Moss reported that Always Chipper finished removing trees. Culverts on TR 143 and TR 132 were replaced. TR 66 North was grader patched before Small's Asphalt Paving chip and sealed it. The road crew has filled potholes throughout the township and dug out the ditch at Feld's on TR 136. Moss plans to order road salt the end of September.
- * Small's completed summer paving projects. They did not perform traffic control while paving and did not mill at the concrete drives or pave over the box culvert on TR 129.
- * Mid Ohio Paving plans to repave TR 144 the beginning of October. Crawford Construction has not returned Moss's phone call about replacing the guard rails on TR 144.
- * Moss shared that he spoke to Don Glosser with the Engineer's office. The county has a sixyear plan for bridge projects.

- * Moss shared that the backhoe got new hydraulic lines from Chappy's, and all the equipment is in good shape. He discussed a grate over the salt spreader on the truck; he will get an estimate from Lincoln Center.
- * Moss obtained a quote from Dexter for a pull behind mower for \$31,090.

MISC:

- * Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, a resolution authorizing Doug Heacock, chairman, to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission state capital improvement and/or local transportation improvement program(s) and to execute contracts as required for the Township Road 132 repaying project. (Resolution attached) Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.
- * Trustees decided to stay with bonds at this time instead of employee dishonesty insurance. Hardwick received the railroad grade crossing evaluation form from PUCO; she will email it to the trustees. Employees need to complete fraud training by the end of September.
