Cardington Township held a regular meeting on November 11, 2024 at 7:00 PM in the township office. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

Trustees: Heacock, Patterson, Green    Fiscal Officer: Hardwick

Employees: Moss & Meyers

Others: Holly Tindall – Brightspeed and three gentlemen from Triple D (Brightspeed contractors)

## PRESENTATION:

\* Tindall shared that Brightspeed plans to install fiber optics for internet service onto their poles and underground. Her map revealed that most of this project will be in the Village of Cardington and not the Township. She has a meeting planned with the Village on Thursday. The Township does not require permits or fees for public utilities.

## MINUTES:

\* The minutes of the October 14<sup>th</sup> meeting were read. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to approve the minutes as read. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

## ZONING:

\* Hardwick read Toombs's zoning report. Toombs had responded to inquiries and investigated a complaint of a camper on a CR 11 property. He sent follow up letters to Davis property (TR 141) and Mollett (US Rt 42).

\* Permit #20241103CT Carl Caldwell, 3940 Twp. Rd. 134, car port addition, fee \$10.

\* Permit #110924CT Anthony Firstenberger, 2787 St. Rt. 529, enclosed porch addition, fee \$20.

\* The Zoning Board of Commission met on Monday, October 21 with Joe Clase – Plan 4 Land. The minutes from the meeting were distributed to trustees. Their next meeting will be November 18 at 6:30 PM. Patterson distributed handouts from Clase with information about planned residential conservation districts.

## ROADS:

\* Moss reported Mid Ohio Paving completed paving of TR 144, road crew has mowed, grader patched, picked up tires and trash, ordered road salt, and installed road signs from the grant. He has to go to Bucyrus for cold patch, and Kokosing is selling hot mix in Marengo. He said he would like to order road number and zoning road signs.

## EQUIPMENT:

\* The grader is broke and parts are not available. The 550 needs to go to Mathews Ford for a noise and a service. Lincoln Center can make a grate for the dump truck. Moss will get snow equipment ready next week. Trustees discussed a new tractor and mower; they plan to attend the OTA Trade Show in January to shop for these. Moss will purchase two exterior doors for the Township hall and garage at Lowe's at an approximate cost of \$850.

## MISC:

\* The cemetery levy renewal passed. Trustees discussed that the fire levy is the next levy up for renewal/replacement. Hardwick completed the railroad crossing evaluation form to submit to PUCO. Hardwick submitted the OPWC application to repave TR 132. Harvey Smith provided a doctor release to return to work.

\* Trustees discussed the Township's electric aggregate. The Township could let the Morrow County Commissioners take over the Township's aggregate. Perhaps the

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County could negotiate for a better rate. One question that was raised – Does the County receive a bonus/stipend from the electric aggregator?

\* Trustees also discussed reimbursement for health insurance premiums.

FINANCIAL:

\* Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to inspect and sign checks 17159-17176 & electronic payment 36. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

\* The financial reports and the <sup>October</sup> ~~November~~ bank reconciliation were distributed for signing by the board. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to accept them as submitted. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

Green moved, Patterson seconded, to adjourn. Time 8:25 PM.
