Cardington Township held a special meeting on December 16, 2024 at 7:00 PM in the township office. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

MINUTES:

\* The minutes of the November 11<sup>th</sup> meeting were read. Green moved, Patterson seconded, to approve the minutes as read and corrected. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ROADS:

\* Moss reported he will order new road number and zoning signs after January 1, high winds are damaging the new sign posts, he has done two days of training with Meyers for snow plowing, and he needs to have Smith come in for training. He is working on a list of projects for 2025. He would like to get rid of the piles of fill dirt at the township garage.

EQUIPMENT:

\* Moss serviced the dump truck, roller, and salt boxes and he ordered filters for the backhoe. Southeastern Equipment cannot get parts for the grader.

\* The Lincoln Center quote for the grate on the dump truck is \$3,175. However, that includes \$650 for sandblast and paint that is not needed. Patterson moved, Heacock seconded, to authorize Moss to negotiate with Lincoln Center for the grate and to spend up to \$2,600. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ZONING:

\* Toombs arrived at the meeting. He reported that he spoke with Lori McGee (Davis property on TR 141) about junk vehicles; Toombs will follow up in January. Mollett (US 42) is not complying with a lot split; Toombs will follow up in January. The property on TR 66 did get their septic inspected by the Health Department. Toombs has received another complaint about the number of cars at Carpenters (CR 137).

\* The Zoning Board of Commission did not meet in November. Instead, Toombs and Patterson met with Joe Clase – Plan4Land to review the updated zoning map. Highways will be zoned commercial 500' each side of the highway. Tentatively, the Zoning Board of Commission will meet on January 20.

MISC:

\* The Township will hold the year-end meeting December 31<sup>st</sup> at 11:00 AM, and the organizational meeting will be after the joint meeting with the Village on January 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM.

\* The current electric aggregate is August 2023 – August 2025 at 7.05 cents. Grace Byler, Morrow County Economic Development Coordinator requested to use the Township Hall for one hour to complete the fair housing training plan that was submitted with the 2022 Community Development Block Grant program; trustees approved the use.

\* Green shared a complaint he received from a property owner on US Rt 42 about the neighbor. Green will talk to the neighbor as a courtesy, but this is a civil matter that needs to be worked out by the neighbors.

\* Patterson shared that the Morrow County Township Association quarterly meeting will be Thursday, December 19 at 6:00 PM. Ohio Road Renewable is planning a large solar

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project on CR 165 in Cardington, Lincoln, and Westfield Townships. They may attend a future township meeting to discuss.

\* The financial reports and the November bank reconciliation were distributed for signing by the board. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to accept them as submitted. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.
