Cardington Township held their year-end meeting on December 31, 2024 at 11:00 AM in the township office. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

MINUTES:

* Hardwick read the minutes of the December 16th meeting. Patterson moved, Green seconded, to approve the minutes as read and corrected. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

* Patterson moved, Green seconded, to adjourn into executive session in accordance with O.R.C. 121.22(G)(2) to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of a public employee or official. Executive session included trustees and fiscal officer at 11:05. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

Executive session concluded at 11:15.

EVALUATIONS:

* Trustees discussed Moss's evaluation with him; Hardwick will email a copy to him. Hardwick will also email Toombs's evaluation to him. Moss completed evaluations of Meyers and Smith; he will have them sign their evaluations.

ZONING:

* Trustees discussed that Kay Patterson's term on the Zoning Appeals Board and Makenzie Coulter's term on the Zoning Board of Commission are up. They do not wish to be on these boards any longer. Trustees are seeking new members.

SALARY:

* Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to pass the following resolution:

"Trustees and fiscal officer of Cardington Township in Morrow County are entitled to the maximum compensation permitted per the Ohio Revised Code" for 2025. This is in response to AG Opinion No. 2000-043 issued late December 2000. Roll call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

- * Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to increase Keegen Moss's hourly rate from \$19.50 to \$20.00. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.
- * Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to increase Chris Toomb's monthly salary from \$450 to \$500. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.
- * Heacock moved, Green seconded, to increase Harvey Smith's hourly rate from \$17.50 to \$17.95. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.
- * Heacock moved, Green seconded, to increase Zach Meyer's hourly rate from \$17.50 to \$17.95 starting April 1, 2025. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ROADS

* Moss reported that he cleared a fallen tree on TR132, and he had to purchase salt from Goodman Snow Services when the backhoe broke down. He plans to put together a book of township road information.

EOUIPMENT

- * The backhoe had died; the batteries from Cardington Home and Auto were under warranty. The tractor is down at the moment.
- * Moss obtained a time and material quote from Southeastern Equipment Company to repair the road grader. It was for \$6,676.93. Moss also pointed out that the windows in the grader are busted out, the cylinders are leaking, and the hoses are an issue. Trustees weighed out the cost benefit of repairing the backhoe versus how much it is actually used. Hardwick will provide information at the next meeting about how to dispose of township assets.

- * Patterson reported that a representative from Open Road Renewables plans to attend the January 13 township meeting to discuss their solar project in Cardington Township.
