Cardington Township held their regular meeting on February 10, 2025 at 7:00 PM in the township office. The meeting was opened with pledge to flag and prayer by Heacock.

Trustees: Heacock, Patterson, Green Zoning Inspector: Toombs

Others: Dan Cech, Gary Goodman, Amy Hoffman, and Jon Mason

DISCUSSION:

* Hoffman, Palmer Energy Company, addressed trustees about electric purchasing program that Morrow County Commissioners oversee for Canaan, Perry, Gilead, and Washington Townships. If Cardington Township wants to join this program, they will need to cede authority to the County Commissioners soon so that Palmer can include Cardington Township with the other townships' request for proposal.

* Goodman, Village fire chief, reviewed 2024 fire department runs.

* Cech, Open Road Renewables, shared his office in open in the village. There will be a public meeting on March 11.

Hardwick arrived at 7:40.

* Mason, Morrow County Commissioner, provided trustees with a county update.

MINUTES:

* Hardwick read the minutes of the January 13th regular meeting. Heacock moved, Patterson seconded, to approve the minutes as read and corrected. Roll Call: Heacock yes, Patterson yes, Green yes.

ZONING:

* Toombs had two lot splits: 1) Michaela Bush at CR 28 & TR 136, 5 acre parcel - \$100
2) Jacob & Delisa Long at CR 132, 2.5 acre parcel - \$100.

* The Zoning Board of Commission met on January 29 with Joe Clase – Plan 4 Land. The minutes from the meeting were distributed to trustees. They have compiled a rough draft of an updated zoning resolution. The Board of Commission is now reviewing the draft; they will reconvene after individual review.

* Toombs is willing to continue serving on the Morrow County Regional Planning Commission as his work schedule allows.

* Patterson shared information he gathered from the Ohio Township Association conference. He would like the Morrow County Township Association to host a training for all township zoning commission and BZA members. He also said that the township can pay these members for attendance at meetings and these boards could also have alternate members.

ROADS & EQUIPMENT:

* Moss was not feeling well and provided trustees with a written report of January activities. The road crew continues to plow snow and salt; they have patched potholes and removed tree limbs. Moss is working on a summer paving list.

* Moss replaced hydraulic lines on the dump truck for the salt spinner and replaced the spinner motor on the spreader. Ronk's Towing had to get the dump truck out of the ditch on TR 138 on February 6.

MISC:

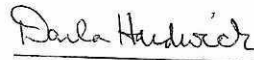
